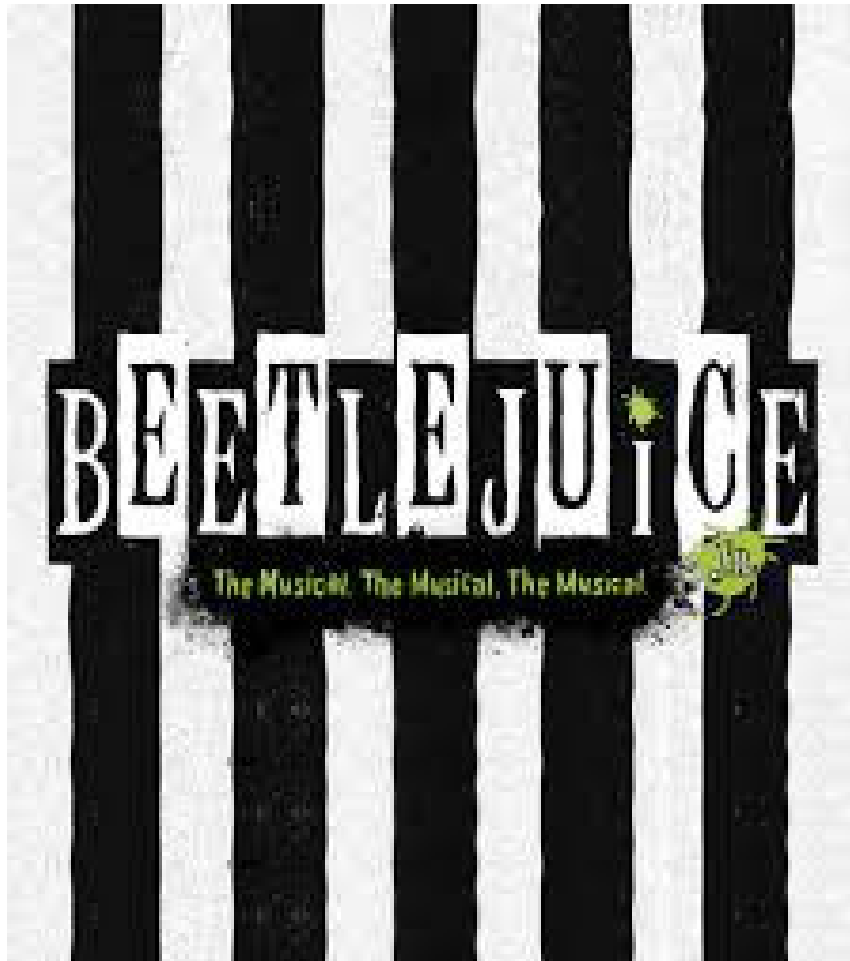

SYNOPSIS

It's our show now, kid. The ghost-with-the-most comes to the stage in *Beetlejuice Jr.*, the frightfully funny musical based on the beloved motion picture turned Broadway phenomenon.

Lydia Deetz is a strange and unusual teenager, still grieving the loss of her mother and obsessed with the whole "being dead thing."
