Business Rules for CEDARS October 1st Enrollment Report:

1. Student is enrolled during the first business day in October of the selected school year.
2. School is student's primary school.
3. If Student is in Pre-K, that student must also be enrolled in a Special Ed program in the district during the first business day in October in order to be counted.
4. If the student has multiple records that meet the above criteria, the detailed report will only show the most recent one.
5. Totals include full time running start students at the highschool.

\* Not provided is not an acceptable ethnic/race category beginning in 2010-2011. Students in this category cannot be included in federal compliance reports and counts.

Note: CEDARS generates this report and Business Services enhances the data to include ethnic group head count totals and percentages. The Oct 1 - Ethnic Race by Gender figures are not meant to be the same as the P223 Enrollment report, which has very different business rules and may also have a different "Count Day" than that used for the CEDARS report. The P-223 includes students when the school is not the student's primary school. (Not responsible for WASL) This may include students with the following status: Home-Based, Private School, Foreign Exchange, Students shared with another school district (Shared students/Varianted).
