From taking pond samples and looking under microscopes to identify organism within the samples, to dissecting worms and small organisms. Students will have a chance to go deeper into biology and do a wide variety of fun experiments to see even the smallest things living around us through microscopes. This camp is for those interested in biology and curious about the world around them.

We will explore peak altitude, aerodynamics, and velocity. All students will have the chance to make a homemade rocket and launch it. This camp is for those budding engineers who love to make things soar, and possibly getting a little messy!

Each session includes a snack and all materials for the camp. Students should bring water bottles to camp with them.


