## **JOB SUMMARY:**

Under the supervision of the site administrator, provides an educational program for pupils in grades TK - 8, or a combination thereof, and assists in other school programs as assigned. A focus on establishing and maintaining an Instrumental Music Program for students in grades 4 - 8. Creates a class environment favorable to learning and personal growth. Establishes effective rapport with pupils' to motivate pupils to develop skills, attitudes, and knowledge needed to provide a good foundation for further participation in the total school program, in accordance with each pupil's ability. Establishes good relationships with parents and other staff members. This position could be split between two separate school sites through an MOU.

## **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Teaches skills in music appreciation, harmony, and explorations in music and instrumental music (band, orchestra, instrumental ensemble) and/or choral music (chorus, choir, choral ensemble) to pupils.
- Develop lesson plans, comprehensive units of study, and instructional music materials and provide individualized small group instruction on specific instruments and ensembles.
- Coordinate with <u>both school site programs</u> to ensure commonality and seamless performances (*if applicable*)
- Establish and maintain standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional general education classroom learning atmosphere. Ensure a comfortable room environment to the extent possible.
- Evaluate students' music skills growth, keep appropriate records, and prepare progress reports.
- Communicate with parents through a variety of means.
- Controls the storage and use of school-owned property; makes minor adjustments and requests repairs to instruments as required.
- Hold parent conferences when needed to discuss the individual student's progress and interpret the school program.
- Cooperate with other professional staff members in supporting students in the instrumental music program
- Create an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays, bulletin boards, and interest centers.
- Maintain professional competence through participation in in-service education activities provided by the District, school, and/or self-selected professional growth activities.
- Perform basic attendance accounting of students
- Attend evening school programs that require student supervision for instrumental music purposes.
- Supervise students in out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the supervisor
