Now, after years of serving at Charlotte Catholic, Mr. Conrad returns to his roots at Holy Trinity Catholic Middle School to help lead us into the next chapter of our school’s legacy.

Above all, Mr. Conrad is a man of deep faith and strong moral character. He believes that Catholic education should focus on virtue, academic excellence, personal growth, and, most importantly, fostering a community that brings students closer to Christ. As we prepare for our transition to Holy Trinity Catholic Academy beginning in the 2026-27 school year, Mr. Conrad’s leadership will help strengthen
