Boys High School Varsity Soccer State Champs!

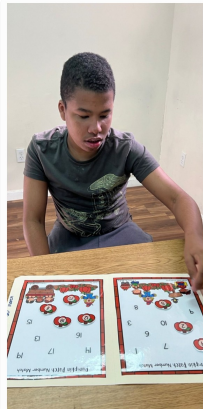

Curriculum Corner

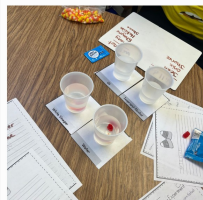
Ms. Casey's Class:

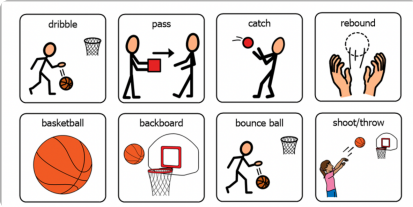
Music Class w/Mr. Jon

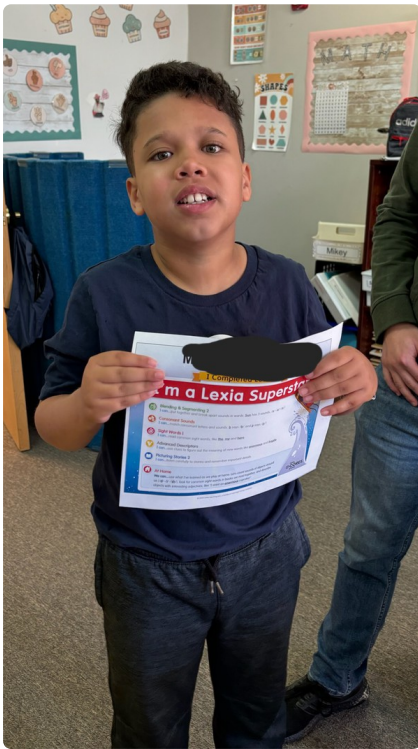
Trick or Treat Training

Core Vocabulary Words

Staff/students in the program focus on particular core vocabulary words each month. See below for a list of activities provided by our Speech Language Pathologists for parents to use at home to support the core words the students are learning...

PARENT HANDOUTS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES
UTILIZING AAC AND CORE WORD OF THE MONTH

NOVEMBER:
Core word of the month = eat/ drink

Activities to model and use 'eat' and 'drink' at home:

1. Mealtime:
Requesting food/ drinks during snack time, breakfast, lunch or dinner:
eat + desired food
drink + desired beverage
Expand into:
I want + eat + food
I want + drink + beverage
Comment on others during mealtime:
you + eat + food
you + drink + beverage
digi/ cat + eat + food
other pet + drink + water

2. Read books or magazines and formulate sentences about what the characters are eating/ drinking. Many children are motivated to talk or label or point out things that you can eat or drink, especially favorite items!
Model/ encourage imitation of verb drink + beverage (point to pictures) You can use favorite characters, boy/girl, pronouns, animals or self.

3. You tube speech and language songs that target core words:
• There are good videos/ songs on you tube that repeat the core words. I like to pause the songs on each side and have the child create the phrase (eat + ___ drink + ___). These are great videos and there is one for many of our core words
• Eat, core vocabulary song by Speech and Language Songs: [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Y1_Ux0MVCQ&ab_channel=Apples and Bananas](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Y1_Ux0MVCQ&ab_channel=Apples%20and%20Bananas)
• Apples and Bananas: Super Simple Songs

4. Play games
• Try playing games that go along with core words of the month eat/ drink. Here are a few suggestions:
- Hungry Hippos (eat marbles)
- Feed the Monster (eat + silly items on the game pieces)
- Hungry Caterpillar game

5. Read books and comment: model 'eat + noun' or 'subject + drink'. Have your

child create a phrase. Include colors or other adjectives if they are ready (eat red apple). Here are some book suggestions:
- Hungry Caterpillar
- Green Eggs and Ham
- How do Dinosaurs Eat Their Food?
