Mr. Jurkowski reviewed the water system and problem that has occurred over the last several years at the High School. His company has received approvals from NYSED and the Harkin Mechanical Contract. The contractor has installed the remedy which was an automatic primer system and it is functional at this time. The contractor will revisit one of the pumps for maintenance due to a bad bearing. His office is finalizing paperwork for NYSED.

Septic System

He reviewed the septic system for the high school and the system failure. His office submitted the design plans to the Department of Health and NYSED. They have received approval from NYSED and are working with the necessary entities in putting together the bidding documents. The attorney and insurance carrier have provided comments and suggestions regarding the coverage. He outlined the anticipated time line with construction beginning in June as school ends. The open bid will be published in papers and journals. The performance bond has a one year maintenance agreement attached to it. Discussion ensued.

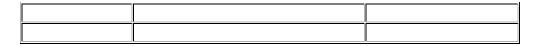

Mrs. Panzer recused herself from the discussion. Ms. Moran discussed using a realtor, there is a fee and she would not go in that direction due to that fact. We have an attorney which does the same and more. She would rather put it out to bid. Mr. Mayville agreed with Ms. Moran. He stated the Board has explored all the different avenues and it was time to make a decision on the direction. Mr. Perotti stated he is in agreement with putting the building out to bid because the District would have more control. He regrets having to put the school building up for sale due to the historical nature of the it. However, with the condition of the building and having to put additional money into the it; he supports the bid process. Ms. Bailey and Mrs. Westfall were in agreement with using bid process. Ms. Moran stated the decision was not made lightly but due to the nature of the roof it's more practical to make decision on selling or bidding. She stated that she wanted to make sure that it is a plus for the community, and that no one is ahead in this process. Mr. McGhee also agreed with the bid process and shared Mr. Perotti's feelings of sadness in seeing the building go to bid. The remaining debt on the building is \$424,000. Mr. Perotti suggested \$600,000 as a good place to start for a minimum bid. Ms. Moran and Mr. Mayville stated the range should be from \$550,000 to \$600,000. The Board agreed with putting the Millerton Elementary School out to bid at \$550,000 for 30 days beginning Monday, December 15 - January 15, 2015. The bid opening will occur on January 16, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. The bid should be advertised from NYC to and Albany.
