Good Cause Exemptions

Under Act 284 (Read to Succeed), third-grade students who are significantly behind in reading may be required to repeat the grade. However, there are exceptions where a student may not have to be retained, such as if they:

- Are learning English and have been in the program for less than 2 years
- Have an IEP or 504 plan indicating they've already received extra help in reading for more than two years
- Have been in reading intervention for 2 years and have already been retained
- Scores Approaches Expectations on SC Ready or scores 941 on the STAR Reading test
