 Amy passed out the packet. Teams spent time reviewing packets.
 Are any of these courses repeatable? Yes, repeatable for credit.

<p>Recommendation to add a box moving forward to add “repeatable” or not under credit value. Consensus to move forward.</p> <p>Remove “you must provide your own guitar” in Beginning Guitar.</p> <p>Tu asked a question about adding courses as “1, 2, and 3.” Dialogue around that.</p> <p>Representatives shared that it would not be a problem because they need to take course 1 before they take course 2.</p> <p>CILT is recommending to rename Guitar and Piano to 1, 2, and 3. Also, adding prerequisites (grades), and teacher recommendation to different levels.</p> <p>Intermediate Guitar- Recommending - leave F credit and remove G credit for Intermediate Guitar. Strike may be repeated for credit in the course description</p> <p>Advanced Guitar - Strike G from the course should not be listed there. Send to Team to update elements in Advanced Guitar.</p> <p>Question - Why is the course description the same for all three Guitar courses? The ELO's make sense but not sure about the course description.</p> <p>Music Appreciation - Remove G. Strike out “Canvas” and leave online lessons.</p> <p>Percussion Ensemble - Remove G.</p> <p>Remove all the G's in packet 3.</p> <p>Dance Choreography - Remove last line in course description. Remove “end of the year” add end of semester. Add repeatable to course.</p> <p>Consensus - to have just one letter not both letter.</p> <p>Intermediate Piano - remove C or better.</p> <p>Advanced Piano - Remove everything about grades for that description. Add language that public recitals “may be required.”</p> <p>Consensus - Courses moved forward as a packet.</p> <p>Packet 4</p> <p>Question about Auto service tech 3 about machinery and taking apart engines. 1 and 2 is basic and 3 is hands-on. Spell out Auto Services Technician.</p> <p>Construction Technology 2 - Missing the G.</p> <p>Consensus to move forward both pathways.</p> <p>Consensus to move forward Culinary 4.</p>
