Parking access & entrance for guests

There is a \$15.00 fee to park at Desert Diamond Arena, which you can pay upon arrival. Graduates are encouraged to ride to the facility with their family for the ceremony, and carpooling is strongly recommended to help ease parking and traffic, as well as to ensure families don't have to pay for parking twice. Any graduate who needs assistance with transportation should reach out to the front office. Parents and guests should plan for approximately 60 minutes to drive and park at the arena. Graduates who drive with family should be dropped off at the entrance on Sunset Blvd, while all guests and graduates will park in Lot G.
