For a smooth and efficient entry process, a **clear bag policy** *will* be in effect, and all guests *will* be required to go through metal detection upon arrival. **No outside food** will be permitted inside the stadium, but each guest may bring **one factory-sealed bottle of water**. In case of a medical emergency, **First Aid/Medical** services will be available at the **south end of the building on the main concourse level**. For any lost and found items, please visit the *Guest Services booth or speak with security at Gate 3*.

Graduation Videos/Photographs

Ordering information for graduation photos and videos from a contracted professional photographer and videographer will be provided to students at graduation for those interested in purchasing. To ensure that all guests have an unobstructed view, parents and guests **will not be permitted to stand or videotape from the aisle ways or near the stage area once the ceremony begins**. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Graduation Diplomas

This year, diplomas will be handed out after the graduation ceremony has concluded. Once the ceremony ends, students will proceed to the **Grand Canyon Room**, located near **Gate 5**, to receive their diplomas. *Parents are not permitted in this area or on the arena floor at any time*, so we kindly ask that you *exit the arena after the ceremony and meet your graduate at Gate 5*. Please note that **diplomas cannot be reprinted**, so it is essential to keep them safe and secure. We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that this process runs smoothly and efficiently.

Additional Information

Programs for the ceremony will be available at **Gate 4**. Lastly, please make arrangements with your graduate to meet outside the venue at **Gate 5**; this is where students will exit after they have picked up their diploma. Again, *Parents are not permitted in the Grand Canyon room or on the arena floor at any time*, so we kindly ask that you *exit the arena after the ceremony to meet your student at Gate 5*. Participation in Graduation

All seniors are encouraged to participate in the commencement ceremony. If any senior is unable to participate, he/she may request to be excused by writing or contacting Leslie McKiernan, Administrative Assistant to the Principal at lmckiernan@ccusd93.net. The ceremony is a dignified ceremony. Appropriate behavior during the ceremony will be strictly enforced and anyone not displaying exemplary behavior will be asked to leave. Any senior student trespassing on the Cactus Shadows campus during non-school hours or involved with any destructive or disruptive activities during the second semester may not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. If you choose to not participate your diploma can be picked up from the front off starting **May 27th from 10:30 AM - 3:00 PM**.
