#### **DUDLEY ATTENDANCE**

This year the government and local authority have put a big focus on school attendance and the importance of all children having access to a full time education. One of the areas within this is lateness and punctuality. If children arrive late at school there are 2 marks that can be given depending on the arrival time.

#### Our academy attendance policy explains:

'Pupils must arrive in school by 8.55am on each school day. The register for the morning session will be taken at 8.55am and will be kept open until 9.25am. '

'A pupil who arrives late: Before the register has closed will be marked as late, using the appropriate code (L) After the register has closed will be marked as absent, using the appropriate code (U) '

This means if a pupil arrives between 8.55am and 9.25am they will be marked as late (L) however if it is after 9.25am they will be given a U code which is an unauthorised late mark and marks the pupil as absent for the morning session.
