Principal's Corner

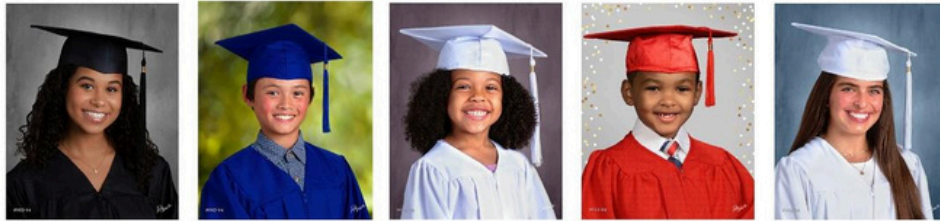

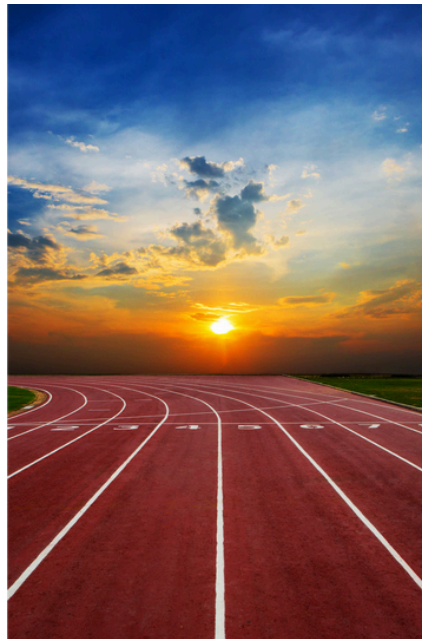

COLLEGE INFORMATION

Please read below to learn more about college and applications! When creating accounts for college-related things, it's best to use a personal email address rather than your school email address. If/when an application asks for your counselor's email address, please put Mrs. Steele's email -- barbourk@gcs.k12.nc.us.

- High School students who are enrolled in CCP (dual enrollment) courses, and are also planning on continuing at VGCC after high school, do NOT have to complete the full VGCC application. They just have to complete this [transition form](#). Students completing the transition form must also still complete RDS. If you have any questions about attending VGCC, you can reach out to Ms. Kimberly Wilcots (wilcotsk@vgcc.edu).
- If you are applying to ANY North Carolina College, you MUST complete the [Residency Determination Service](#). Take this seriously - if you rush through it, it may determine that you are not an NC resident, and therefore, will be charged out-of-state tuition unless you successfully go through the reconsideration process. You will use your CFNC account to complete this. More information about RDS is towards the bottom of the newsletter.

CFNC

College Foundation of North Carolina (CFNC) is a GREAT tool to help plan for and apply to college. Go ahead and make an account if you don't already have one! This site houses all North Carolina Community College applications. If you plan on attending VGCC, or any other NC Community College, this is where you will do your application! Community college applications are always free. You can also apply to North Carolina universities through CFNC.

FAFSA

If you are planning on applying to college (2 or 4 year), plan on completing the [FAFSA](#)! You can do FAFSA before your college applications, you do not have to wait.

FAFSA stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This application will tell you what financial aid you are eligible for based on your family's income.

Completing the FAFSA should be a TOP PRIORITY for college-bound students.

This is how most students get the majority of their financial aid. FAFSA can tell you what loans, grants, and scholarships you are eligible for. A loan is borrowed money that you must pay back. Grants and scholarships are gifted money that you do not have to pay back.

You will need your parent(s)/guardian(s) 2023 tax return(s) to complete the FAFSA.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are another way to get financial aid for college. You can apply to scholarships two different ways.

The first way is completing the FAFSA! When you do the FAFSA, it'll ask you to check off what schools you'd like to give access to your FAFSA. Once you've gotten in to a school and listed them on your FAFSA, they will go in and look at your FAFSA to determine if they'd like to grant you one of their institutional scholarships (no additional application required). There are also state/federal scholarships, such as the [NEXT NC Scholarship](#). This is a financial aid program that helps most North Carolinians from households making \$80,000 or less pursue higher education by fully covering tuition and fees at any community college or more than half, if not all, of tuition and fees to attend any public university in the state.

The second way is by applying to separate applications for specific scholarships. They are a ton of scholarships out there, so I've compiled a list of some for you (link at the top of this page)! It's not a complete list, so feel free to do your own research as well! These scholarships can be institutional (money comes from the school) or private (money comes from an organization/business).
