POSITION OVERVIEW:

This person is responsible for the day-to-day operation of the boys hockey program. Qualified candidate must fully support the [vision & values](#) of Southwest Christian High School (SWCHS) and the Athletics philosophy.

Position Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide a vision for the boys hockey program:
 - Develop team expectations through the handbook and other communications
 - Develop off-season training and conditioning program
 - Develop a plan to involve lower-level coaches and programs
- Coaching and related administrative duties:
 - Participates in practice sessions that are both engaging and instructive, conducted on a regular basis to develop the athlete's greatest potential; teaches fundamental skills of hockey.
 - Coaches and instructs students, individually or in groups, regarding the rules, regulations, equipment, and techniques of the sport; follows MSHSL requirements.
 - Observes students, during competition and practice to determine the need for individual or team improvement; provide necessary feedback.
 - Responsible for communication with the players and parents regarding expectations, schedules, etc.
 - Works with the Athletic Director in scheduling facilities for practices and competitions.
 - Participates in special activities, including parent's night, banquets, and award nights.
 - Oversees equipment and systematic return of all equipment at the finish of each session and season.
 - Assigns duties to an assistant coach as necessary.
 - Attend coaches' meetings as assigned by the Athletic Director.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Previous head coaching or extensive assistant coaching experience at the high school level or higher.
 - Demonstrated ability to assess player's skills, monitors players during competition and practice.
 - Demonstrates solid organizational skills and ability to effectively communicate verbally and in writing; maintain effective working relationships with school staff, parents, and students.
 - Must possess a thorough knowledge of the rules, regulations, strategies, and techniques of volleyball.
- Ability to be flexible with personal schedule for practices and games.
