Unless objected to in writing by September 17, 2024, the District herewith gives notice of intent to provide, release or publish information on the District's website and in publications such as local, school or student newspapers, magazines, yearbooks, daily or weekly newspapers, athletic programs, musical or theatrical programs or to the military (11th & 12 grade students), any or all "directory" information as may be appropriate under the circumstances. Directory information includes student names, names of parents, address, age, height, weight, grade, major field of study, photographs, student participation in recognized school activities, extracurricular activities and sports programs, academic honors, achievements, awards, scholarships and similar information. **Parents who do not desire release of any of the directory information during the 2024-2025 school year must make specific requests in writing. Failure to make such a request shall be deemed consent.**
