








Franklin & Stevenson held a Night at the Museum at Oakmont Senior Living Center!

Riley Upper Elementary held a Pizza, Popcorn, and Paperbacks event!






Hoover Elementary made a sweet impression with their Candyland reading month decorations! Students were simply amazed as they entered the school!




Cleveland Elementary set up a March Madness bracket, featuring favorite books!




Board of Education Trustee Mark Johnson read to a classroom at Kennedy Elementary! This was one of several visits by Mr. Johnson at schools all around the district!






Stevenson's Mock Trial teams competed at the Oakland Regional Competition, finishing in the top three and qualifying for State Competition!






