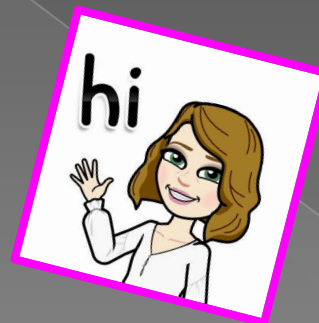

Cell Phones

However, neither BlueTooth (AirPods), nor Smart (Apple) Watch technology are allowed to be in any Ranger's possession at Tevis.

Yes, you are allowed to have a cell phone on campus, but it must be **“Off & Away!”**

It must be turned completely **OFF**
(Powered Down all the way, not just on Silent...)

& **AWAY** (inside a purse or backpack) at **ALL** times.
(Any time you are inside the gates of Tevis Jr. High School)

If you have an emergency or need to talk to a parent you **MUST GET ADULT PERMISSION!**

Use of cell phones for texting and/or cheating will result in disciplinary consequences and confiscation of the phone if we hear or see it outside of student's purses or backpacks, including the outline of a cell phone that is being kept in a pocket or clothing.

Chromebook Expectations



\$309 Replacement Cost

- ★ No food or drinks next to your Chromebook.
- ★ Carefully close. Earbuds and pencils cause screens to crack.
- ★ Insert cords and cables carefully. Never transport with anything plugged in.
- ★ No writing, drawing or stickers.
- ★ Must have all barcodes and original name tag on them at all times. No alterations.
- ★ Must use the same Chromebook designated by the teacher each day.

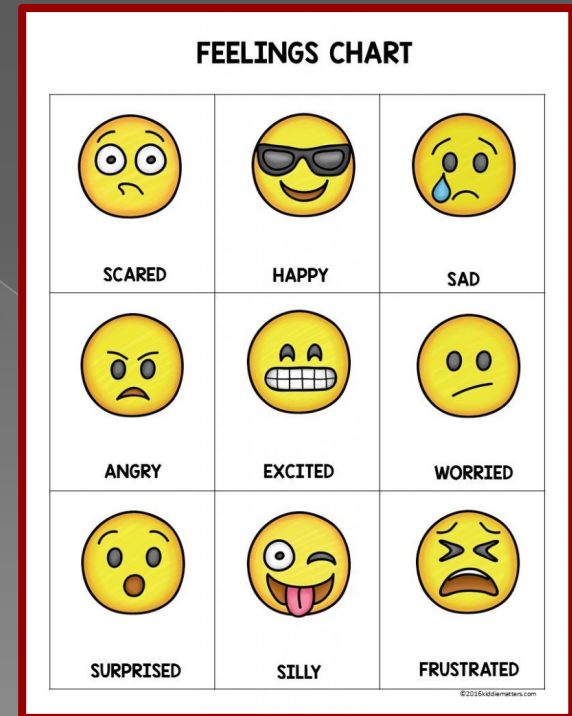

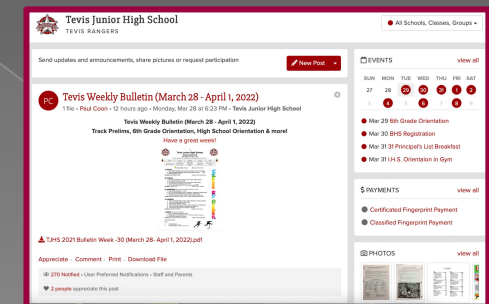
