Zanewood Community: A STEAM School is part of Osseo Area Schools' magnet programs, made possible through a collaboration with the Northwest Suburban Integration School District (NWSISD). If you wish to attend Zanewood but live outside the school's attendance area please review the important information below and visit [nws.k12.mn.us](http://nws.k12.mn.us) for more information about the application and lottery process.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

*(For those who live outside Zanewood's attendance area)*

- **Online application:** Complete and submit an online application through NWSISD's website, [nws.k12.mn.us](http://nws.k12.mn.us). The application portal opens in mid-October.
- **Priority application period:** The priority application period extends from mid-Oct. through Dec. 31.
- **Lottery process:** For more information about the lottery process, please visit [nws.k12.mn.us](http://nws.k12.mn.us).
- **Second chance:** The application portal re-opens in January, with a second lottery held in March.
- **Sibling priority:** If your child has a sibling attending Zanewood the same school year, an application must be submitted by the priority deadline to increase their chances of securing a seat.
- **Transportation:** Free transportation is available to students if you live within the school districts of Anoka-Hennepin, Brooklyn Center, Buffalo-Hanover-Montrose, ISD728 (Elk River-Otsego-Rogers-Zimmerman), Fridley, Osseo or Rockford.
