
In addition, if your comments are of a critical nature about specific people, the Board requests that you present your comments during the personnel portion of the "executive session."

We have exciting news about two of our Thunderbird scholars, Jeremy Price and Daniel Martinez. Over the summer, Jeremy was researching information about becoming an actuary, and he found information about a nationwide competition called "Modeling the Future Challenge". Jeremy recruited Daniel to enter the competition with him. In this competition, students are challenged to develop and present their own mathematical models describing how they envision new technologies or industries impacting the future.

This week the semi-finalists were chosen, and I am excited to announce that their team has been selected to move on to the next phase of the competition. There were about 100 semi-finalists chosen from across the nation to move on to the project phase where students will be creating their own project proposals. They will also have the opportunity to work with a mentor who is currently working as an actuary. In March, the field will be narrowed down to 15 finalists who have a chance to compete for scholarships.

This has been a completely student-led and student-driven initiative. This is just one of the wonderful things our Thunderbird scholars are doing.
