Dear CCHS Parents and Students,

Student course registration begins this week. All students will have the opportunity to meet with their counselor to review course recommendations and build their course list for the 2025-2026 school year. The goal is to help students build a schedule that is both challenging and manageable. While colleges seek students who challenge themselves academically by taking advanced courses, including Honors and AP when qualified, it's essential to maintain a balanced schedule.

The <u>course registration process</u>, which begins with recommendations from current academic teachers, is outlined on the school website. Counselors will meet students to discuss course placement and for students to select electives according to the following schedule:

- Current juniors Thursday, March 20 and Friday, March 21
- Current sophomores Monday, March 24 and Tuesday, March 25
- Current freshmen Thursday, March 27 and Friday, March 28.

If a student meets course prerequisites but is not placed in the appropriate level, he/she should contact the student's current teacher. Counselors will be available after March 28<sup>th</sup> to address parent questions about course placement recommendations.
