All students are issued 2 plastic tags, plastic sleeve, lanyard and plastic loop for the Bus Tag and the School Tag that is used in the Cafeteria and Library.

All students who ride the bus must have a bus tag to board the bus. Emergency replacement bus tags are \$1.00 each.
