

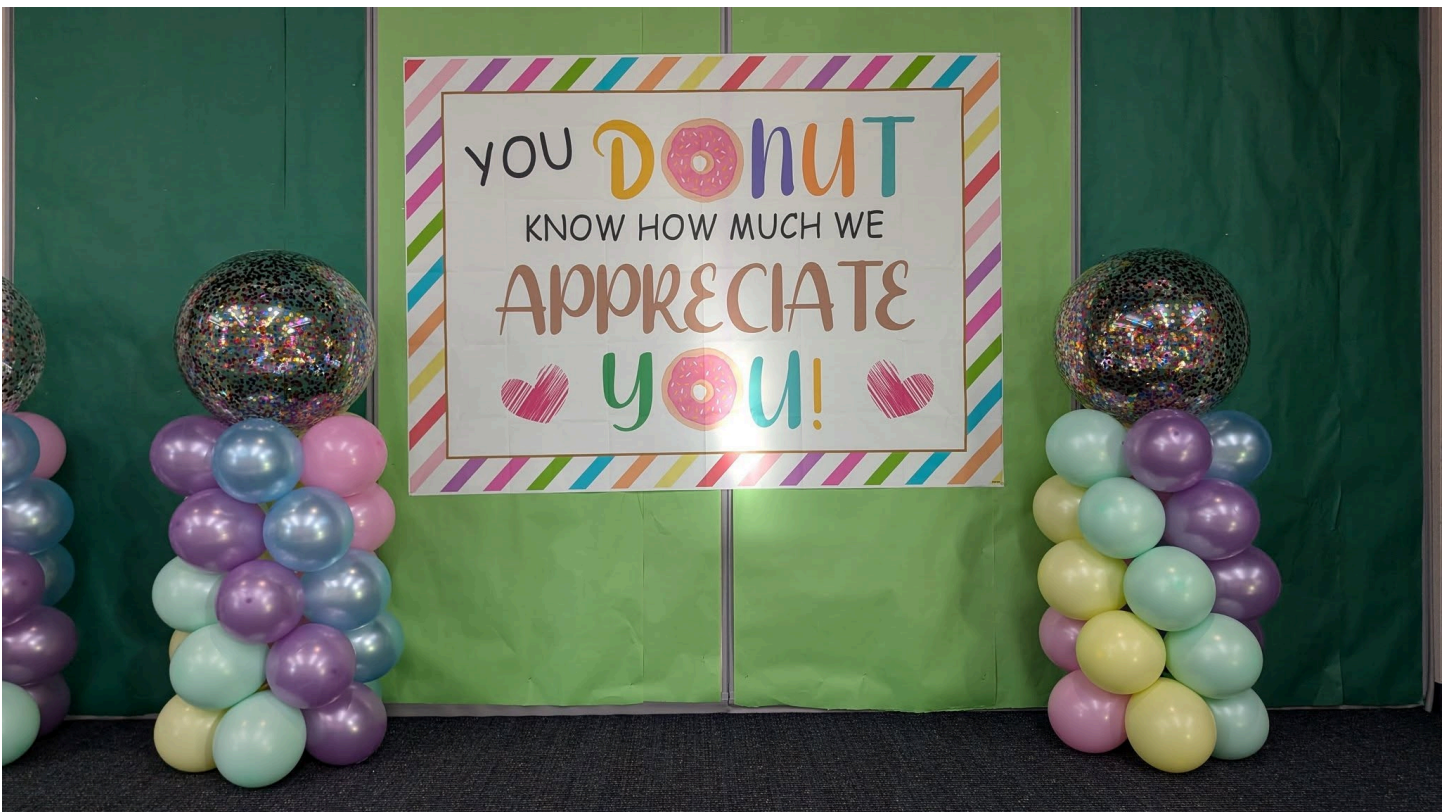

REGISTRATION IS OPEN FOR 2025-26

Resident student enrollment for 2025-26 is now open for **incoming kindergarteners and new K-12 students** to the Mead School District! Many of you are already part of the school district, but please share this message with families, friends and neighbors who are new to the district! Visit www.mead354.org/enroll for more information and links to online registration or PDF paper registration packets.

Current Mead School District students do not need to re-enroll. Students are eligible to register for Kindergarten if they turn 5 years old prior to September 1, 2025.

The Mead School District is also accepting applications and interest forms for students in the following programs:

❖ **Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program at Midway Elementary**

- Now accepting applications for Kindergarten-age students (Age 5 before Sept. 1).
- There are limited opportunities to enter the First Grade cohort, as space is available. Eligibility will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- For incoming kindergarten students, 20 spots are available through lottery process after applications are received.
- Regular kindergarten registration must be completed prior to submitting DLI application.
- DLI Program is housed at Midway Elementary, but open to students from anywhere in Mead School District.

- ❖ **Transition to Kindergarten** (if Age 4 on Aug. 31, 2025)
 - Free, full-day early entrance kindergarten for children who are 4 years old by August 31, 2025, AND have had limited access to full-time preschool.
 - Students must demonstrate either financial, academic OR social-emotional need AND cannot be currently enrolled in another early learning program.
