REGISTER NOW! DO IT IN !

If it seems too early to register for the 2023-2024 school year, it is not! In fact, early registration greatly benefits your student and helps them get off to a great start in the school year. A major benefit of registering your child during the early enrollment period is that all student registration fees are waived. When you register early, it . . .

- allows students to start school on the first day of the new term.
- keeps students from missing valuable instructional time.
- gives students a better opportunity to select the elective classes of their choice.



This year, school registration is easier, cleaner, and takes about 10 minutes to complete. Like last year, registration is online only. However, it is all in PowerSchool Enrollment Express. Some parents are already familiar with PowerSchool and have an account to access, in real-time, their student's assignments, grades, and attendance, as well as request reports, email teachers, and more.

Create a Parent Single Sign-on Account

PowerSchool makes access to students' information easier thanks to a single sign-on option. It allows parents to create one account to access information for each child in the family.

- Parents of new students will receive a separate Access ID and Password for each student from the district.
- Parents of returning students will have Access IDs and Passwords from the previous year.


If you have forgotten your student's password, a password reset is available in PowerSchool. However, if you have forgotten the Access ID, please get in touch with the school office.

Once you have your child's Access ID and Password, you are ready to set up a PowerSchool account.



USING POWERSCHOOL IS EASY!

Log into PowerSchool at <https://ttdistrict205.powerschool.com/public/home.html>. Whether you are familiar with PowerSchool or new, follow the instructions below to create a single sign-on account. It's done in three easy steps.




STEP 1.


Select "Create Account."

The next screen will confirm that your PowerSchool account has been created. Next, log back in using your **Username** and **Password**. This is the area you will log into on all future visits to PowerSchool, including to enroll for the 2023-2024 school year.

The parent portal is accessible from any desktop or mobile device. Parents can log in to see their children in one place and receive current grades, assignments, scores, attendance, schedules, and school bulletins.

The PowerSchool Mobile App can be downloaded at the Google Play or Apple App stores. The District Access Code needed to use the mobile app is **XJJN**.

Student Access to PowerSchool

New students will receive an Access ID and Password from your school. Returning students will have an Access ID and Password from the previous year. If you have forgotten your Access ID or Password, please get in touch with the school office. Log into PowerSchool at <https://ttdistrict205.powerschool.com/public/home.html>. Then, enter Access ID under Username and Access Password.

The student portal is also accessible from any desktop or mobile device. Students can log in to see their grades, assignments, scores, attendance, schedules, school bulletin, and more.

You can complete the process at home or, if you would like assistance from our staff, you can use one of the registration kiosks that are located in the lobby of each District 205 high school building. They are available Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Please contact your child's school to confirm that staff will be available at the time you want to arrive and to be notified of the location of the kiosks.

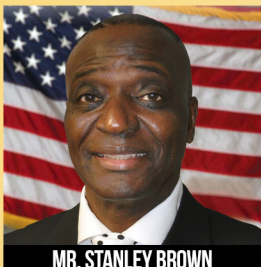

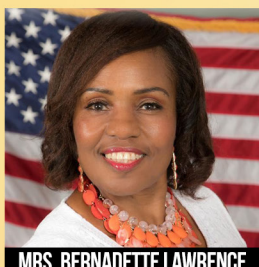

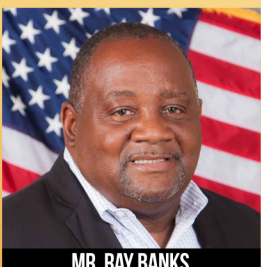

Medical Clearance Q & A

What is Medical Clearance?

Medical clearance is a required step of School District 205's student registration process. It helps the District to create a safe environment for students and staff and ensures that students are healthy enough to attend classes and participate in other school activities.

What do parents need for Medical Clearance?

Parents are required to provide the following documents to their child's school:

- Incoming freshman or transfer students:
 - current physical
 - current immunization
 - current dental
 - emergency contact
 - administration of medication
- Senior students:
 - proof of the meningitis vaccine

Are students required to be vaccinated for COVID-19 in order to register for school?

Currently, students are not required to be vaccinated for COVID-19

Is there a deadline for Medical Clearance?

Parents are encouraged to complete school enrollment in PowerSchool and to provide medical clearance document no later than **Friday, June 30, 2023**. The link to PowerSchool is located on the District 205 website (www.district205.net).
