



## WHERE CAN I PARK MY CAR?

Because OIS is situated in a relatively dense part of Bekkestua, there are limited parking options immediately adjacent to the school. Fortunately, we are near many public transportation options, so we encourage the use of public transport. However, we also understand that there are occasions when driving to school is necessary.

### Parking Options near Oslo International School

- **On-Site School Parking** (zone 2 overleaf): Though limited, spaces are available behind the sports hall. Please note that we operate a one-way traffic system around school. *GPS Coordinates: 59.9201797,10.5835022 Address: Gamle Ringeriksvei 53*
- **Staff Parking** (zone 3): This parking area behind school (opposite Coop Mega and Rema) is reserved for staff. *GPS Coordinates: 59.918656, 10.584072. Address: Gamle Ringeriksvei 43*
- **Coop Mega & Rema 1000** (zones 4 & 5 overleaf): Families may utilise the pay-and-display underground lots at these nearby grocery stores. *GPS Coordinates: 59.918656, 10.584072. Address: Gamle Ringeriksvei 43*
- **Nadderudhallen & Nadderud Arena** (zones 6 & 7 overleaf): Parking spaces are available across the playing field near Nadderud swimming pool (car number plates should be registered upon arrival at the pay-and-display machines). *GPS Coordinates: 59.921444,10.5854476 Address: Haukeveien 12*

Note that the off-campus parking locations listed above are not under the management of OIS and may be susceptible to change.

## PARKING AND DROP OFF ZONES

- ➔ Zone 1 (in green) indicates morning drop off point by main gate.
- ➔ Zone 2 (in light blue) indicates free school parking area (please only use this area if you are in school).
- ➔ Zone 3 (in dark blue) indicates staff parking.
- ➔ Zones 4, 5, 6 & 7 (in yellow) indicate municipal parking areas.



### Additional Considerations:

Consider public transportation when possible.

Plan to arrive with sufficient time for parking and respect no-parking zones.

Always drive carefully around school (students may be crossing at various unmarked points).
