Notice of Intent to Destroy Special Education Records from 2018

According to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), 34CFR300.573, school districts must notify parents when the information contained in their child's special education records is no longer needed to provide public educational services to their child. This is public notification to parents or eligible students (students who are of legal age except where guardianship or conservatorship has been established) of the District's intent to destroy all special education records from 2018, except for archival information such as name, grades, attendance records, classes attended, grades completed and number of years completed for its own records based upon federal law, for those students age 24 years and older. Parents or eligible students have the right to request these records. Persons who want their records should contact the Greenbush-Middle River School Office between 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on weekdays no later than Friday, May 1, 2025.
