








### Oxford High School Teacher of the Year Keren Wells
















### 2003 Dow Jones Newspaper Fund Journalism Teacher of the Year



Beth Fitts came to Oxford High school over twenty years ago as an English teacher. She began teaching a Journalism class with one typewriter and no Journalism textbooks. The Oxford High School Journalism Department is now made up of an award-winning team of students, who under the tutelage of Mrs. Fitts, have gone on to win numerous

awards.

The latest award given to Mrs. Fitts is the 2003 Dow Jones Newspaper Fund Journalism Teacher of the Year award. Because of this award, one senior at Oxford High School will receive a \$1,000 scholarship to study Journalism in her honor.
