
BOYS' BASKETBALL
















SOCCER

The Wizard of Oz

The Wonderful Wizard of Oz staged at OHS Feb. 9th & 10th

About the Dlay ...

One of the true classics of American literature, The Wizard of Oz has stirred the imaginations of young and old alike for almost a hundred years. Originally published in 1900, it was the first truly American fairy tale, as L. Frank Baum crafted a wonderland out of such familiar items as a cornfield, a scarecrow, a mechanical woodsman, and a humbug wizard who used old-fashioned hokum to express that universal theme, "There's no place like home." Between 1901 and 1902, Baum provided the book and lyrics for a stage adaptation of The Wizard of Oz. A Chicago composer, Paul Tietjens, added the music and W. W. Denslow designed the costumes and "scenic color effects." In 1939 MGM produced the film version, which is now considered by many to be the most popular film of all time. Since 1939, many stage versions have been based on the film and its songs. In the 1970's the original story gave birth to an off-Broadway musical, The Wiz, which was later filmed.
