


Live Oak Park Pickleball Project

- City received interest from community members requesting pickleball courts in Temple City.
- City conducted a Pickleball Pilot program at Live Oak Park and collected use and impact data.
- City Council reviewed data from the pilot program and approved new pickleball courts.
- Converted Court 7 at Live Oak Park to four permanent pickleball courts.
- Council recently approved an additional four pickleball courts at Live Oak Park. Opening estimated in May 2025.

Temple City Park Playground Project

- Replacement and enhancement of 20+ year playground
- Bamboo Forest theme was selected from over 300 responses at the Community Outreach Workshop. The selected design is meant to blend with the natural surroundings of Temple City Park.
- Playground & Picnic Shelter Amenities
 - Main tower hub with slide and overhead clumbers, spinning elements, swings, sensory panels, custom safety surface design, renovated picnic shelter with LED lighting, and landscape buffer.

LOP Playground Project

- Replacement and enhancement of 20+ year playground
- Space theme was selected from over 300 responses at the Community Outreach Workshop, and drew inspiration from the former "rocket" playground at LOP.
- Almost 20,000 sq./ft. footprint, over 5 times larger than playground at Primrose Park.
- Playground Amenities
 - Full custom shade structures
 - Main three tower hub for ages 5-12, play structure designed for 2-5 years, swings, spinners, net climber, sensory panels, exercise equipment, lighting, landscaping, storm water capture, benches and picnic tables.
- Completion Date Estimate May 2025






Construction Progress – October 2024










Sereno Open Space Project

- City acquired the residential property at 5003 Sereno Dr., located in the southwest portion of the City.
- The southwest portion of Temple City is rated as a "high" park need area, as identified by the 2016 L.A. County Parks Needs Assessment.
- Demolition of the existing structure began in March 2025.
- Landscape Architect for project is SWA, same designer of the playground renovation projects.
- City received \$185,000 from L.A. County for design services.


Sereno Open Space Project





- Preliminary concept options (4) were developed for the project site and reviewed by City Council.
- After review, City Council approved a park project at the former Chamber of Commerce site at the corner of Las Tunas Dr. and Sultana Ave.
- City will release a Request for Proposals (RFP) for design services for the project.
- Project Timeline Estimate: Summer 2025 End of 2026
