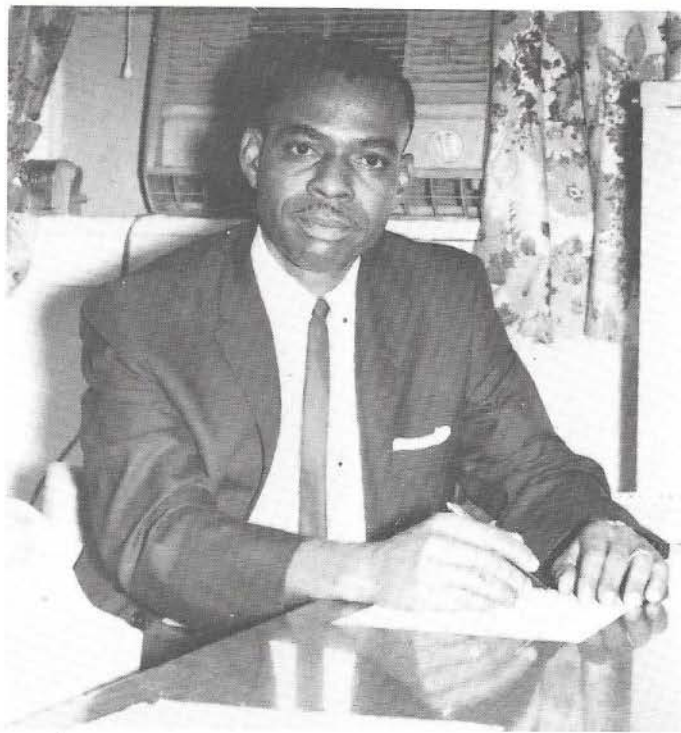


MR. D.B. SANDERS, Principal
