

Advanced Placement Scholar Cord

Requirements:

- A) To apply, student must have completed 5 AP level classes in 4 different content areas (English, Spanish, social sciences, science, math and art).
- B) Students must have completed the courses with a B grade or better.
- C) Students must present their transcripts in order to receive signatures.
- D) Students must get signatures from their teachers for each AP course they are submitting on this application (5 Signatures).
- E) Students must have a 3.6 or higher cumulative weighted GPA.
- F) Students must have taken AP exams and/or be registered (proof) for senior year AP Exams for all courses being submitted for consideration. Scores of 3 or better qualify.
- G) Students must be approved through administration for behavior clearance.

- If you meet these requirements, print out your transcripts and present them to each of the teachers from each course you are submitting for approval. If the teacher approves your course grade, then they will initial in the space provided. All initials, courses completed, and grades will be verified as part of the approval process.
