

**Articulation Agreement
between
Sinclair Community College
and
Great Oaks Career Campuses**

The purpose of this agreement is to establish a close working relationship between Sinclair Community College ("Sinclair") and Great Oaks Career Center to support career technical education programs that lead students to complete an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Applied Science, Associate of Technical Study, Associate of Individualized Study, or a Certificate Program.

Credit for courses can be achieved by students through this bilateral agreement and applied as appropriate based on Sinclair's specific program requirements. These credits are subject to Sinclair's Prior Learning Assessment policies, which can be found at <https://sinclair.edu/services/welcome-center/academic-advising/pla/>, as they may be amended from time to time.

Credit is achieved as proficiency credit through a student successfully passing assessments (with a "C" grade or better) approved by Sinclair faculty for a course on the Tech Prep Credit Option Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit A. Course credit and grade will be posted to a Sinclair transcript as proficiency credits (A#, B#, or C#). Students must approve having their credit posted to their transcript and complete the Tech Prep Application Process.

Articulated credit is achieved through successful completion of the high school course or credential aligned with the Sinclair College course. These credits are posted as articulated credit (AA) if the student scores a grade of "C" or higher or achievement of the associated credential. In addition, students must approve having their credit posted to their transcript and they must complete the Tech Prep Application Process.


