#### **Agreement Purpose**

This agreement recognizes career and technical center students who follow a seamless curriculum pathway from high school to a postsecondary associate degree or credential at the University of Cincinnati Clermont College. A graduate who successfully completes academic and technical course competencies required in the secondary program is eligible to receive college credit for the courses specified in this agreement.

#### **Student Responsibilities**

Students seeking college credit through this agreement will:

- Complete high school competencies associated with the LIVE OAK's Manufacturing Engineering
- Technology program in a pathway aligned with the University of Cincinnati Clermont College's
- Submit an application for admission to the University of Cincinnati Clermont College (www.ucclermont.uc.edu)
- Submit an official high school transcript
- Obtain Career and Technical Prep College Credit Transmittal Recommendation from the designated
- administrator at the career and technical center. Submit the signed form to the University of Cincinnati
- Matriculate to the University of Cincinnati Clermont College Manufacturing Engineering Technology program within two years from high school graduation.

## **Secondary School Responsibilities**

High school instructors and administrators will:

- Complete a Career and Technical Prep College Credit Transmittal Recommendation form for each
- student prior to his/her graduation; provide a signed copy to the student and maintain a file copy
- Communicate to students and parents the requirements and process as outlined in this agreement for obtaining the University of Cincinnati Clermont College articulated credit

### The University of Cincinnati Clermont College Responsibilities

When a student matriculates to the University of Cincinnati Clermont College and submits the Career

- and Technical Prep College Credit Transmittal Form, the Registrar will record achieved articulated course credit on the student's college transcript
  - The University of Cincinnati will waive tuition and fees for articulated credit
- The University of Cincinnati Clermont College has evaluated these course competencies and agrees to
