You are receiving this letter because you have taken or are currently taking at least one Advanced Placement (AP) class during the current school year. We are confident that the rigor of the course(s) you have taken or are taking has prepared you to be successful on the AP Exams; however, to assist you further, Liberty High School will be offering students the opportunity to take practice AP Exams in many of the curricular areas covered by the AP exams.

The practice AP Exams listed below will be administered on **Thursday, April 24th** which is a "B" day. There will be two exam sessions: one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Although taking practice AP exam(s) is optional, we highly encourage you to sign up for one or two practice exams as they allow students to experience full-length tests and simulated testing conditions. Each exam will take no more than three hours to complete. Students taking an afternoon practice test or who take morning AND afternoon tests will eat "A" lunch that day. Students who normally attend CCCTC will remain at LHS that day. If your AP course is not listed below, contact your AP teacher for information about reviewing for the exam.

If you would like to participate in practice AP exams, please complete and return this paper to Mrs. Seegren in the Counseling Office no later than **Friday, April 4th**.
