A proud 2009 graduate of Glassboro High School, Erin Bernat was a standout athlete on the Field Hockey and Softball teams. Her achievements on the field earned her induction into the Glassboro High School Sports Hall of Fame in 2024.

After high school, Coach Bernat continued her academic and athletic career at Rowan University, where she excelled as a key player on the field hockey team. Over her collegiate career, she amassed impressive statistics in scoring and assists. As a senior, she served as team captain and was named to the New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) All-Conference First Team. Her accolades also include selection for the North/South Senior All-Star Game, the Eastern College Athletic Conference Mid-Atlantic All-Star Team, and recognition as a Rowan Scholar-Athlete for all four years.

Following graduation, Coach Bernat pursued a career in teaching and coaching. She has served as a Health & Physical Education teacher while leading field hockey and softball

programs as Head Coach at both Gloucester City High School and Glassboro High School. Additionally, she had a brief tenure coaching field hockey at Rowan University.

Since 2019, Coach Bernat has been a Health & Physical Education Teacher at Kingsway Regional High School and Middle School, where she is known for her enthusiasm, dedication, and commitment to student success. She has served as Kingsway's Assistant Field Hockey Coach, helping lead the team to numerous division titles and three consecutive NJSIAA Group IV State Championships.

As Erin Bernat steps into this new role, her commitment to fostering a positive and competitive environment remains steadfast. "Kingsway has built a tradition of excellence in field hockey, and I am honored to continue that legacy," said Coach Bernat. "I look forward to working with our student-athletes, helping them grow both on and off the field, and pushing them to achieve their highest potential."

Coach Susan Massara has been a Health & Physical Education teacher at Kingsway Regional High School since 2022. She previously led the middle school field hockey program and currently serves as the Head Coach of the Kingsway Flag Football Team, which secured the West Jersey Flag Football League (WJFL) Championship in the 2024 season.

Before joining Kingsway, Coach Massara taught at the Woodstown-Pilesgrove Regional School District, where she served as the Head Field Hockey Coach. Her leadership earned her the **South Jersey Times Field Hockey Coach of the Year** honor in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2018, and 2021. She guided her teams to multiple division titles and South Jersey Group 1 Championship victories in 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, and 2021.

Massara earned her bachelor's degree from Rowan University, where she played NCAA field hockey and was named **Midfielder of the Year** in 2007.

Lana Lowry – Junior Varsity Assistant Coach

A dedicated member of the Kingsway faculty since 2000, Coach Lana Lowry brings extensive coaching experience, having served as an Assistant Coach for Middle School Boys' Soccer, Girls' Lacrosse, and Field Hockey. She teaches Health & Physical Education at Kingsway Regional High School and was named **Teacher of the Year** in 2013-14.

Coach Lowry is a **role model** who builds **meaningful relationships** with her students, inspiring them both in the classroom and on the field. She is committed to making every practice and game **enjoyable and impactful**, helping her players develop a **love for the**

game and grow as young women. Her dedication to student-athletes and the Kingsway community makes her an invaluable asset to the program.

Meredith Wuzzardo – Freshman Assistant Coach

Coach Wuzzardo joined Kingsway as a paraprofessional in September 2024 and recently served as the Varsity Girls' Basketball Assistant Coach. Previously, she worked as an instructional aide at Bridgeton High School. Before her time at BHS, Wuzzardo was at Indian Avenue School, where she was recognized as the 2020-2021 Educational Professional of the Year. She has also coached middle school softball and field hockey, as well as high school girls' basketball.

Wuzzardo attended Cumberland County College (now Rowan College), where she played softball as a catcher and was honored with the Most Dedicated Award for the 2012 season.

The 2025 season is set to begin on August 18th, and the appointment of Head Coach Bernat and Assistant Coaches Massara, Lowry, and Wuzzardo marks the beginning of an exciting new chapter for Kingsway's Field Hockey Team.
