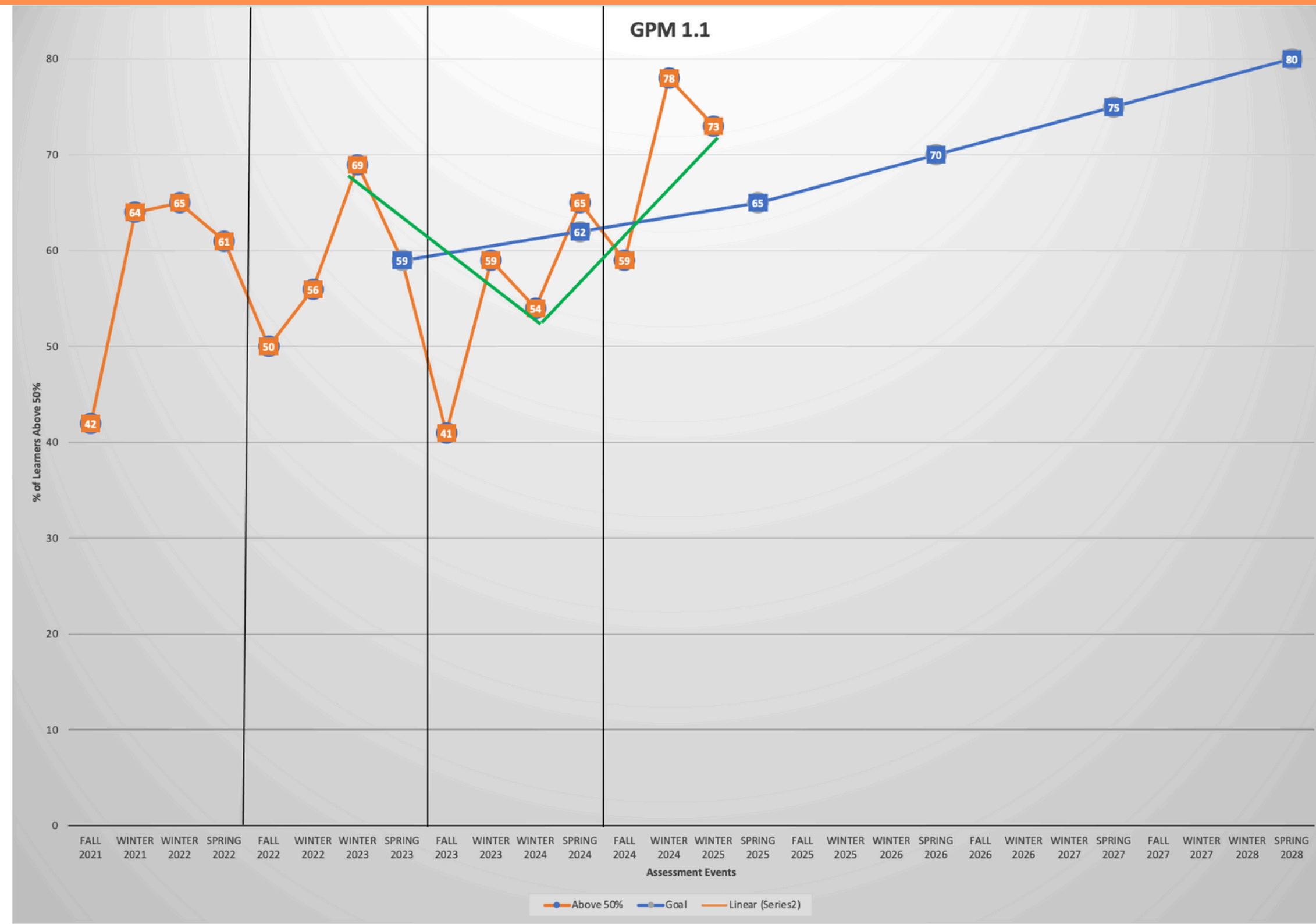


Student Outcome Goal 1

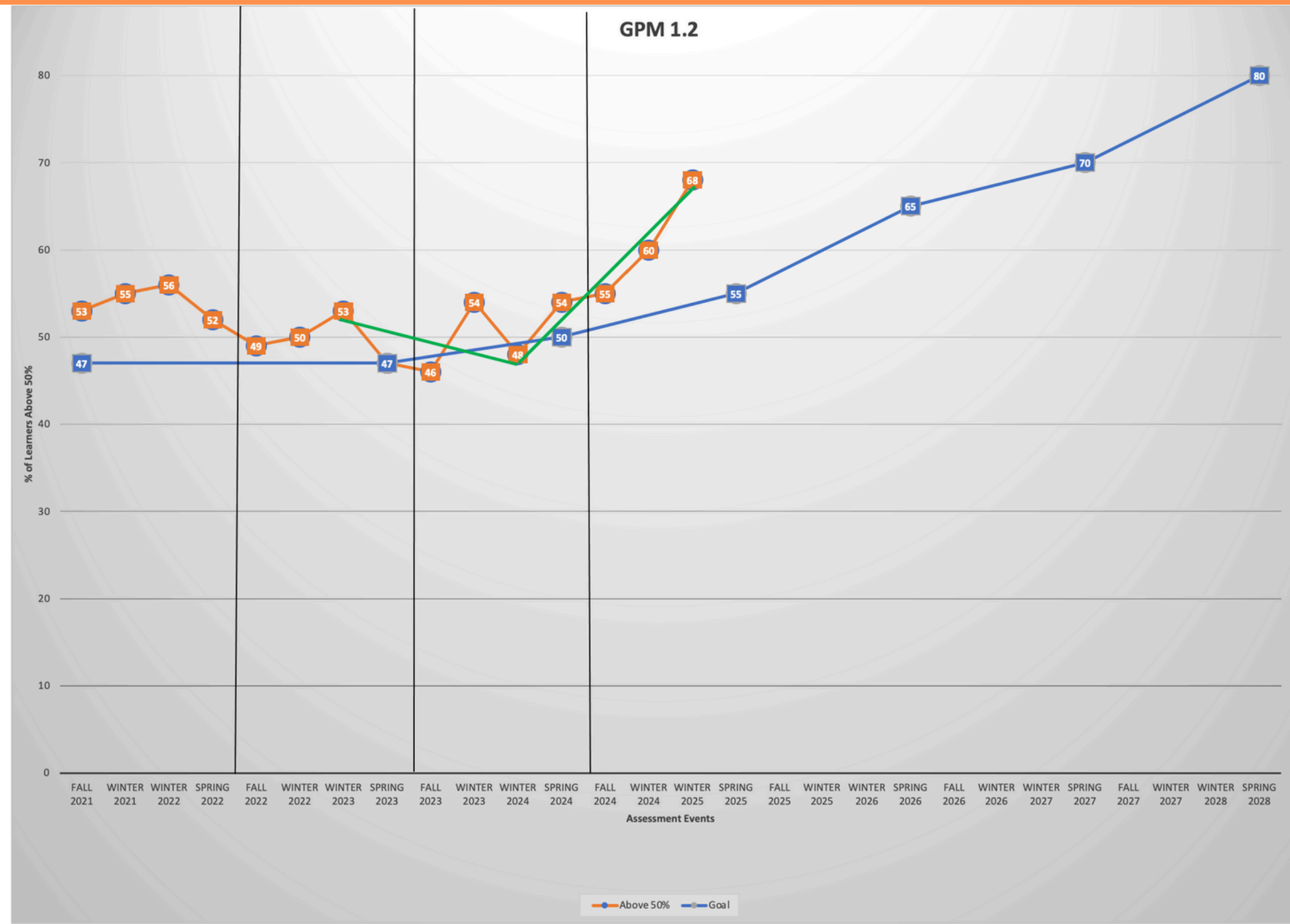
OPS WILL INCREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS WHO ARE PROFICIENT OR ABOVE IN GRADES 3-8 AND GRADE 10 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (ELA) AS MEASURED BY THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE ASSESSMENT (NDSA) ELA FROM 52% IN SPRING 2023 TO 80% IN SPRING 2028.

ANNUAL TARGETS: BASELINE 2023-52%, 2024-55%, 2025-60%, 2026-70%, 2027-75%, 2028-80%

GPM 1.1: The percentage of K–2 learners that score at 50% or above on STAR Reading will increase from 59% in spring of 2023 to 80% by spring of 2028.



GPM 1.2: The percentage of 3–6 learners that score at 50% or above on STAR Reading will increase from 47% in spring of 2023 to 80% by spring of 2028.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RESPONSE

****71% OF OUR STUDENTS IN GRADES K-6 SCORED ABOVE THE 50TH PERCENTILE COMPARED TO 51% AT THE SAME TIME LAST YEAR. THAT IS A STARK DIFFERENCE AND AMAZING AMOUNT OF GROWTH!**

****ON THIS REPORT THE TRENDLINE EMPHASIZES THE CHANGES IN OUR YEARLY DATA BETWEEN LATE WINTER TESTING EVENTS.**

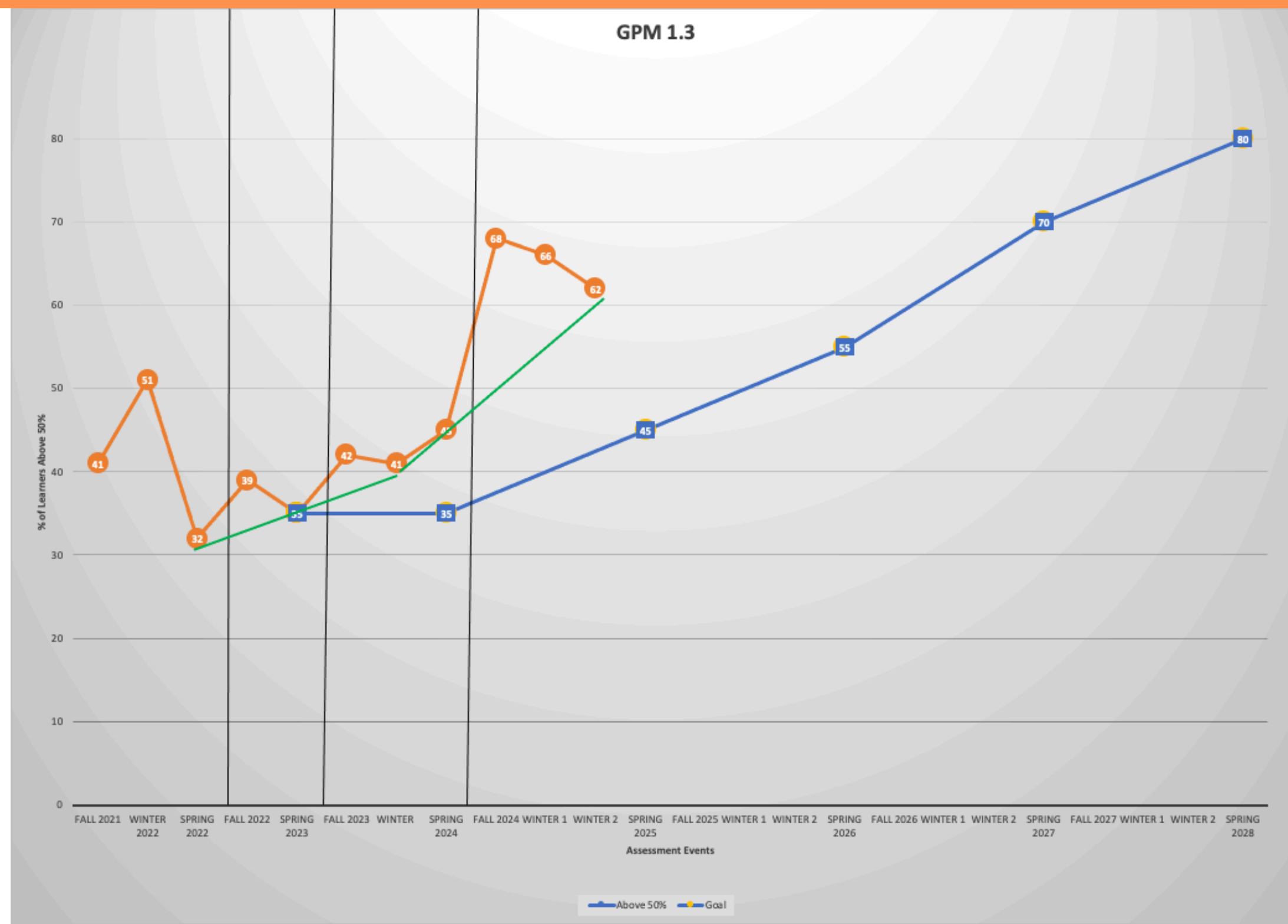

SUPERINTENDENT'S RESPONSE

**THE TRENDLINE I INSTERTED CONNECTS EARLY WINTER TESTING IN 2022 AND 2024 TO LATE WINTER TESTING IN 2025. THIS IS THE FIRST YEAR THAT OUR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS HAVE TESTED IN ALL 4 EVENTS.

**WE SAW A SLIGHT DECLINE FROM FALL TO EARLY WINTER TO LATE WINTER; HOWEVER WE ARE STILL FAR ABOVE OUR GOAL AND ON TRACK TO MEET OUR GOAL.

**DUE TO THE TIMING OF OUR TESTING WINDOW AND THE DATE OF OUR BOARD MEETING WE HAD TO ADJUST OUR TESTING TIMES AT LAST MINUTE. LAST WEEK AND THIS WEEK WE HAVE HAD LEARNERS AND TEACHERS MISSING FOR ILLNESSES AND VARIOUS OTHER ABSENCES, SO OUR NUMBER OF LEARNERS TESTING DROPPED...POSSIBLY AFFECTING OUR SCORES.

**GRADE 7, 8, AND 10 WILL BE TESTED USING THE NDSA IN APRIL AND LOOKING AT THESE STAR SCORES...WE PREDICT THAT WE WILL DO WELL .

**GRADES 7-10 WILL BE STAR ASSESSED ONE MORE TIME BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR.
