The e3 Learning Model was designed to facilitate innovative instruction across all learning studios. This model outlines the framework for how teaching and learning happens at e3.



Engage

- **Connections:** Scholars collaboratively explore real-world, career, community, and cross-curricular connections related to the day's concepts.
- **Curiosity:** Scholars participate in inquiry-based activities and collaborative thinking tasks that ignite curiosity and deepen their understanding.
- **Community:** Scholars cultivate a supportive learning community dedicated to meaningful exploration and the practical application of knowledge.



Educate

- **Learning Outcomes:** Scholars demonstrate academic growth and learning competency toward curriculum standards and co-created learning outcomes.
- **Active Learning:** Scholars actively engage with the presented material through inquiry-based and technology-driven guided instruction, demonstrating focus and participation in discussions.
- **Critical Skills:** Scholars develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills through rigorous learning experiences.



Empower

- **Personal Voice:** Scholars are empowered to select from a range of innovative activities that reflect their personal voice and choice, allowing them to demonstrate their learning in various ways—individually or collaboratively—through the use of technology, or research-based methods.
- **Reflective Practices:** Scholars engage in reflective practices to evaluate their growth, solidify their understanding of self and how to apply their skills, all while upholding principles of integrity in demonstrating their mastery and progress.
- **Community & Civic Engagement:** Scholars apply their learning in real world opportunities that make a positive impact on their communities.

The process is not linear. Instead, instruction flows in and out of each e3 phase based on alignment with content and learning outcomes.

To support this instructional approach, professional development, instructional coaching, and instructional evaluation are all aligned with the e3 Learning Model, promoting effective collective learning facilitation among educators and scholars.
