Overview

Trussville City Schools is seeking a Public Address Announcer/Coordinator for its home athletic games, starting with the 2016-17 season. The PA Announcer's duties include announcing starting line-ups, all game action, public address announcements, presentations, contests, and other duties as assigned, such as screening and developing musical playlists and assisting with the development of athletic programs.

The PA Announcer is the main voice of the Huskies. The PA Announcer works closely with the Administration to create a fan-friendly, appropriate, entertaining experience in Husky Athletic Facilities.

- Ability to multi-task in a stressful environment
- Comfortable announcing to crowds of over 5,000 people on a microphone
- Develop approved game day scripts
- Oversee musical playlist for all athletic events
- Help develop athletic event programs
- Comfortable announcing complex names from a variety of ethnic backgrounds
- Expected to attend all home football, basketball, baseball, and softball home games
- Available to attend appropriate pregame meetings
- Receptive to both positive and negative feedback
- Ability to be spontaneous and react quickly as appropriate
- Develop a substitute list and obtain an approved substitute in his/her absence
- Obtain an approved substitute for concurrent events
- Comfortable working closely with Principal
