



## Frequently Asked Questions About Saber Summer Spectacular

**Q: What makes Saber Summer Spectacular unique?**

**A:** Saber Summer Spectacular offers a dynamic blend of fun, learning, and growth for students. With specialized classes designed to engage and challenge, it provides a supportive environment tailored to diverse learners. Whether your child is exploring new interests, strengthening academic skills, or making new friends, this program is a summer experience like no other. We offer academic classes to keep student learning, and enrichment classes for students to explore and be challenged in non-academic ways. While TNCS' mission is for students who have dyslexia and other related learning differences (and we have classes specific for students with dyslexia), we have created our classes to meet the needs of every learner who is a rising 5-12th grader.

**Q: When are your classes?**

**A:** We have two, two-week sessions (June 16-27; July 7-18). You may sign up for one or both sessions. Most classes typically take place Monday through Friday. Dates and times are available on our summer course catalog and when you register.

**Q: My child does not attend The New Community School. Can they still be part of Saber Summer Spectacular?**

**A:** Absolutely! Saber Summer Spectacular is open to all students, regardless of whether they attend The New Community School or not. Each year, we have a healthy mix of students from across the Richmond area.

**Q: How do I register and pay for summer programming?**

**A:** You can register online through the link on our Saber Summer Spectacular website. Payment options include credit card and electronic transfers. Full payment details and when balances are due are provided during the registration process.

**Q: How does the deposit process work when I register my child?**

**A:** A deposit is required at the time of registration to secure your child's spot. This deposit is typically \$100. It is applied toward the total program cost and may be refundable under certain conditions outlined in our cancellation policy. Then, on May 9, the balance for your registered classes will be paid by the card you have on file.

**Q: How can I change a class after registration?**

**A:** To make changes to your child's schedule after registration, please contact [Doug Kasselberg](#) as soon as possible. Changes are subject to availability. Please review our cancellation policy for more information.

**Q: I have more than one child who will be attending Saber Summer Spectacular. Do I need to register each one separately?**

**A:** Yes, each child must be registered individually to ensure accurate scheduling for the classes they wish to take.

**Q: I want my child to tutor with you over the summer in addition to Saber Summer Spectacular. Can you arrange tutoring to align with Saber Summer Spectacular, so I can avoid back and forth carpooling?**

**Q: My schedule is crazy one day. Can I drop my child off early, so I can make my appointment?** While we are only expecting students up to 10 minutes before their scheduled class time, please reach out to Saber Summer Spectacular Coordinator [Doug Kasselberg](#) to talk about a unique scheduling conflict and if TNCS can do anything to help you out.

**Q: Where are your medical forms?**

**Q: My child takes medicine during the day for allergies. How does this work?**

**A:** Our staff is trained to assist with medication administration. During the registration process, there are a few questions that ask about your child's medical needs. Please provide detailed instructions and any necessary documentation during registration, and we'll ensure your child's needs are met. Someone will also get in touch to make sure you have the correct medical forms on file with us and we have the medicine on the first day of class.
