These shells are essential for enhancing sound projection and clarity, creating an optimal acoustic environment for performers and audiences alike. RATIONALE

The clarity and projection provided by the shells encourage innovative approaches to repertoire and artistic interpretation, allowing performers to take creative risks and achieve new levels of artistry.

Innovation:

The incorporation of advanced acoustic technology represents a commitment to forward-thinking education and performance standards. By integrating cutting-edge design in the stage environment, the project fosters an atmosphere where students can experience and contribute to the innovative possibilities of sound and space.

Activities:

Timeline:

- Spring 2025: order three acoustic sound shells with awarded funds
- Spring 2025: receive three acoustic sound shells and use for spring performances
- Spring 2026: apply for more funding
