THE COUNSELORS' CORNER

Spring Break is just around the corner! I (Mrs. Ellis) am always looking for free or inexpensive activities for my family. Sometimes it's hard to know where to look! I want to introduce you to a program called <u>Museums for All</u> that might be the perfect fit for Spring Break fun. Through <u>Museums for All</u>, those receiving food assistance (SNAP benefits) can gain free or reduced admission (\$5 or less per ticket) to more than 1,400 museums throughout the United States. There are children's museums, science museums, and even zoos on the list! In addition, there are several Ohio museums with <u>FREE</u> general admission for all visitors regardless of income. Here are a few highlights:

- <u>Akron Zoo</u>: Open in the off-season (through March 31) from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm each day. \$3 per person for up to 4 tickets with an EBT card and valid ID.
- <u>Ashland County Historical Society</u>: Open Tuesdays through Fridays from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. There are four different buildings to explore!
- <u>Buckeye Imagination Museum</u> (Mansfield): Open Tuesdays through Sundays from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm; extended hours on Thursdays until 7:00 pm. \$5/per person for up to 4 tickets with an EBT card and valid ID. This is one of our family favorites! Their second floor was recently remodeled and is a treasure trove of activities for children who are 48" and above. There's Skee-Ball, Laser Maze, Interactive Mini-Golf, and more! Memberships are also available.
- <u>Cleveland Museum of Art</u>: Open Tuesday through Sundays; check out their website for hours. General admission is <u>FREE</u> for everyone. Reserving pre-paid parking is recommended. This museum is a site to behold wow!
- <u>COSI</u> (Columbus): COSI offers reduced rates (\$5 per person for up to 8 tickets) for those who qualify for SNAP, Medicaid, or Ohio Directions.
 COSI is a popular attraction, so you'll want to reserve tickets ahead of time. Head to <u>cosi.org/tickets</u> and click on <u>Museums for All</u> for more info.
- <u>Kingwood Center Gardens</u> (Mansfield): Open daily from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm. \$1 per person for up to 5 people from the same household with an EBT card and valid ID. Look for the peacocks on site!
- For those willing to travel a little farther, check out <u>The National Museum of the U.S. Air Force</u> in Dayton, Ohio. It's the world's largest military aviation museum! General admission and parking are FREE for everyone.
