We are excited to announce that we are offering our 8th grade students the opportunity to travel to Washington, D.C. in November 2025. We will be leaving Clarence Middle School on Tuesday, November 4th in the morning and returning in the evening on Friday, November 7th.

Our trip will include a visit to several historic sites in and outside of Washington, D.C. Travel arrangements have been made with Metro Tours, Inc. The itinerary includes a visit to some of the Smithsonian museums, tours of several monuments and memorials, and admission to the Spy Museum, Udvar-Hazy Air & Space Museum and the National Aquarium in Baltimore. There will also be a Potomac River dinner cruise on the Spirit of Washington.
