2. Treasure Report & Budget
 - a. Current balance \$31,489.42.
3. Teacher Grant Request
 - a. Bee Programming Robots for Kinder, 1st, SSN (Ms Weaver), estimated cost of \$1,600
 - i. Includes 12 bee robots, 12 decks, 2 charging stations and 5 mats.
 - ii. Able to use 10% discount and pending grant
 - iii. Kayla motions to approve \$1,600 to pay for Bee Programming Robots, Carrie seconds. All in favor, no objections.
