



ACCOMPLISHMENTS



Lower Moreland High School has earned a prestigious place on the College Board's AP School Honor Roll for the 2023-24 academic year. We

are thrilled to announce that our school has been recognized for its exceptional commitment to expanding Advanced Placement opportunities and supporting student success in these rigorous courses. Additionally, Lower Moreland High School has received the distinguished AP Access Award. This special recognition celebrates our school's success in creating inclusive pathways to advanced coursework, ensuring that our AP program reflects the diverse makeup of our student body. We have demonstrated that access to challenging academic opportunities is a priority for all our students.

Five students at Lower Moreland High School have been named semifinalists in the prestigious National Merit Scholarship competition. The nationwide program has named some 16,000 semifinalists, or less than 1 percent of the nation's high school seniors. Three additional LMHS students were named as Commended Scholars.

The District was selected for a 2024 Best Communities for Music Education Award from The NAMM Foundation.

The NAMM (which stands for the National Association of Music Merchants) Foundation's Best Communities for Music Education award recognizes and celebrates school districts for their support and commitment to music education and efforts to assure access to music for all students as part of a well-rounded education.



Lower Moreland High School students have the opportunity to attend the Eastern Center for Arts and Technology (EASTERN) for technical education, including programs in Allied Health, Automotive Technology, and the Culinary Arts.

Dual Enrollment courses are offered through our partnerships with Gwynedd Mercy University and the University of Pittsburgh.

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation. All students who have met proficiency criteria through school-based programs, community-based language programs, or life experiences can earn the Pennsylvania Seal of Biliteracy.
