Pre-School Registration for City Residents Only

Pre-School application packets for the 2025-2026 school year can be picked up at the Rogersville City School office beginning April 1, 2025 thru April 30, 2025, between the hours of 8:30 am and 2:30 pm, Monday thru Friday. Registration will be in the RCS lobby on Friday, April 4th and Friday, April 11th between the hours of 12:00 noon and 2:00 pm.

City Residents - Pre-School: State law requires that students must be four years of age on or before August 15th of the current year in order to be enrolled in Pre-School.

Eligibility Requirements for Pre-School:

- Live within the city limits of Rogersville/proof of residence required
- Turn 4 on or before August 15th, birth certificate required
- Family meet low income guidelines/proof of income required

Bring the following documents to attach to application (Pre-School):

- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of child's social security card (optional)
- Proof of residence (utility bill or lease agreement)
- Proof of family income
- Current Tennessee Certificate of Health (Physical) and Immunization
- Parent's Driver's License
- Legal Documents (Custody Papers/Parenting Plan/Foster Care/Divorce/Guardianship, etc.) If Applicable

Kindergarten Registration for City/County Residents

Kindergarten application packets for the 2025-2026 school year can be picked up at the Rogersville City School office beginning April 1, 2025 thru April 30, 2025, between the hours of 8:30 am and 2:30 pm, Monday thru Friday. Registration will be in the RCS Lobby on Friday, April 4th and Friday, April 11th between the hours of 12:00 noon and 2:00 pm.

City/County Residents - Kindergarten: State law requires that students must be five years of age on or before August 15th of the current year in order to be enrolled in Kindergarten.

City/County Residents wishing to enroll a child in kindergarten at the Rogersville City School should bring:

- Copy of the child's birth certificate ("Certificate of Live Birth"),(A "Mother's Copy" is not the same as the "Certificate of Live Birth". You can go by the Health Department and they will print you a copy of the live birth certificate. There is a charge for the birth certificate at the Health Department.),
- Copy of the child's social security card, (optional)
- Proof of residence utility bill (electric, water, gas, etc.) or lease agreement
- Current Tennessee Certificate of Health (Physical) and Immunization Record
- Parent's Driver's License Copy
- Legal Documents (Custody Paper/Parenting Plan/Foster Care/Divorce/Guardianship, etc.) If Applicable
