
Dear Mr. Papageorge:

This letter summarizes the Three-year Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) Asbestos Re-Inspection and Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) Update report prepared by Fuss & O'Neill, Inc. at the Mill Hill Elementary School located at the 635 Mill Hill Terrace, Fairfield, Connecticut (the "Site"). The inspection was performed for Fairfield Public Schools (the "Client"). This report is an important document that must be kept on file at the school as well as at a central location where the AMPs are maintained.

The Mill Hill Elementary School was recently fully renovated, asbestos abatement and renovation activities occurred from 2020 to 2021 and no-asbestos containing building material (ACBM) was used in the renovation.
