RUNNING START BASICS

- Dual credit program for high school juniors and seniors
- Available fall, winter, and spring terms. Summer is also available under much narrower stipulations.
- Tuition paid through Running Start
 - *Students responsible for fees and books*
- May take up to 21 college level credits per term
- 15 credits = typical full time class load
- 1 high school credit = 5 college credits
- 100-level courses and above

HOW TO QUALIFY

- Must be in 11th or 12th grade
- Must complete Guided Self Placement for English
- Summer: Students leaving the 10th grade and entering the 11th grade are eligible for 10 credits during the summer before they begin the 11th grade year.

PIERCE COLLEGE POSSIBILITIES

- Associate degrees, bachelor's degrees, professional/technical certificates
- Some pathways transfer to 4-year institutions
- Online, in-person, and hybrid classes available
- Can be full time or part time college student
- This is *your* experience

Summer, Fall, Winter, Spring Term Registration Opens:

Returning Students May 12, 2025

New students May 27, 2025

Summer Term Classes Begins:

July 1, 2025

Fall Term Classes Begins:

September 22, 2025

- **Complete Admissions (Now):**
 - Complete online admissions application for Fall 2025
- **Complete Guided Entry Processes (watch for your acceptance email):**
 - Complete online New Student Guide (New Student Orientation)
 - Complete Guided Self-Placement (GSP) for English (required) and Math placement (*optional if taking math at High School and not completing associate degree*)
 - Complete Intake and Engagement Form
- **Meet with your HS counselor and verify your graduation requirements**
 - Review high school graduation requirements and obtain EVF (Enrollment Verification Form)
 - Submit EVF to Pierce College through Canvas (self-enroll in EVF submission tool on Running Start webpage)
- **Get Connected and Registered (April – September)**
 - Schedule a degree planning + registration session with Advising Office
 - ***Bring graduation requirements to your appointment!***
 - Register for your classes
 - Obtain books/materials
 - Pay remaining balance

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

Program Stipulations

- ▣ **Costs**
 - Fees, books, supplies, transportation
 - Fee waiver available
- ▣ **Courses 100-level and above**
- ▣ **EVFs must be submitted each term or you may be dropped from classes**
- ▣ **FERPA: Student privacy**
- ▣ **Permanent transcript**

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

Keys To Success

- ❑ **COMMUNICATION**
- ❑ **Self-advocacy and self-direction**
- ❑ **Know your resources**
- ❑ **Attendance and engagement**
- ❑ **Maturity**
- ❑ **Time management (high school, holidays, extracurricular activities, work, studying)**
- ❑ **High school graduation requirements need to be known (annual enrollment)**

ANNUAL ENROLLMENT

- **Plan for whole year**
 - Locked into classes early, one time
 - Arrange commitments accordingly
- **Know your high school graduation requirements**
- **EVFs submitted on term-by-term basis**
- **Early enrollment advised – less options as term nears**
- **Edit schedule as needed**

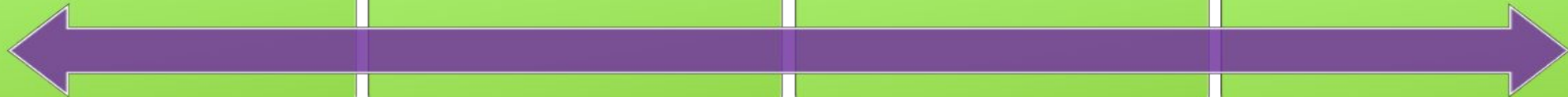

Things to consider...

- ❑ College classes may conflict with High School classes.
- ❑ Remain in contact with High School to meet all graduation requirements.
- ❑ Running Start does NOT pay for:
 - ❑ student fees, books, or supplies
 - ❑ classes under 100 level
- ❑ **Maturity is Essential!!!**

- College in the High School
 - Take college level courses taught by a certified high school instructor at your home high school.
- Advanced Placement credit
 - Certain scores on AP Exams can equate to college credit.
- Career Technical Education Credits
 - Earn college credit through CTE courses at the high school.
