Kerrville, TX (March 24, 2025) – Kerrville Board of Trustees approved the hiring of Curtis Neill as the new Tivy High School Athletic Director and Head Football Coach during its meeting Monday night.

Neill comes to Kerrville from Klein ISD, where he was the Assistant Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator for Klein Cain High School.

Neill’s offense at Klein Cain was the leader in District 15-6A, as the team was district champs with an overall record of 9-2, 7-1 in district games this past season with a playoff appearance.

Prior to Klein Cain, Neil served as Assistant Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator at Cypress Ranch High School for four years, and Cypress Woods High School, both in Cypress Fairbanks ISD for 15 years, with multiple years of playoff runs.

Neill holds a bachelor’s degree in Kinesiology from Texas Southern University, where he was a four-year starter as a tight end and punter, earning All-Conference honors all four years.

He is scheduled to begin with KISD the week of March 31.
