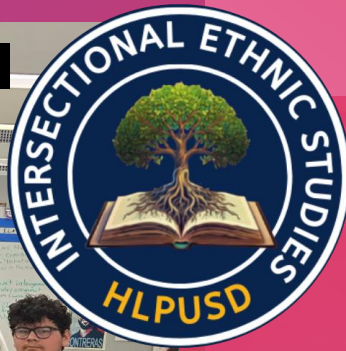
The Spartan Way...Smarter, Stronger, Kinder!
