About 90 sixth grade band students from each of the Fargo Public Schools District's middle schools will participate in a special honor band experience called the Band Festival o' Fun at Discovery Middle School on Thursday, March 27.

The middle-school musicians, led by band instructors from Ben Franklin, Carl Ben Eielson, and Discovery, will rehearse new music together during the afternoon and prepare it to perform at a concert in the Discovery Auditorium at 6 p.m. The concert will also feature special guest performances by ensembles from North High School, South High School, and Davies High School.

Students completed written applications to be selected for the honor band. They were then chosen to participate by their band teachers.

The festival will begin with a full group rehearsal where the students will be introduced to their new music and begin learning it. They will then break out into smaller sectional groups to focus on each section's individual parts. The full group will then reconvene to rehearse the music as a full band again and put the final touches on the performance pieces before the night's concert.
