## Reports

Mrs. Teran and Mrs. Todd provided resources that educated parents on how they can support their child in reading at home. Kinder families were provided letter name and letter sound resources, 1<sup>st</sup> - 3rd grade families high frequency words, and 4<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> comprehension resources.

Each grade-level presented a portion of our Leader In Me initiative teaching the parents and community members about the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People.

Mr. Eberwein explained our school's participation in Title I stating that we are funds are targeted for the entire school. She further explained what participation in Title I programming means, including:

- how our funding is allocated
- how to obtain a description and explanation of the school's curriculum;
